

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1: Why are the roads closed?

A: Marine Parade and the side roads around the display site will be closed for the safety of the event and access by emergency services and to prevent residents being inconvenienced and inundated by day visitors.

Q2: How will I get to my property when the road is closed?

A: Holders of Resident Passes will be allowed through road closures to gain access to properties, except where the Air Show event prevents access. Some roads may also have no vehicular access.

Q3: Is my blue badge valid in this area?

A: No, a blue badge holder must display the Resident Pass alongside their blue badge. Where parking restrictions are clearly displayed blue badge holders must comply with the notice.

Q4: I have meals delivered each day – will I still receive these?

A: We recommend that you contact your supplier to make them aware of the Air Show and possible disruption. However, marshals will allow these services through the closures if they explain their purpose for gaining access.

Q5: I have a carer / NHS home visit as well as daily pharmacy deliveries – how will this work?

A: We recommend that you inform your care provider to make them aware of the Air Show and possible disruption. We suggest that you pass on your Resident Pass to your care provider ahead of the Air Show. If you are unable to do so then your carer will need to explain their purpose to the road closure marshals.

Q6: Can I cycle on the closed roads?

A: Yes, you may cycle on closed roads but not within the event zone along Marine Parade between the Piers.

Q7: What parking will be available to people living and working on affected roads?

A: Parking will be available, except where there is a parking suspension in place. Please see notices displayed on site.

Q8: How do I get access to Marine Parade?

A: There will be no vehicular access to Marine Parade. For safety and welfare reasons Marine Parade between the Britannia Pier and Wellington Pier will be closed to vehicular movements from 23.59 on Friday 15th June until 23.59 on Sunday 17th June.

Q9: Someone has parked across my driveway which means I cannot get my car out, what shall I do?

A: Contact the Air Show Residents Line (on next page) and they will inform the necessary authorities.

Q10: I cannot park where I normally park in Zone A – so where do I park my car?

A: Residents of Zone A with valid permits can park anywhere within the zone except where road closures and suspensions are in place.



TOP TIPS

- Where possible, make all your journeys over the weekend on foot or on a bicycle
- If you have a car, leave it parked over the weekend
- Make only essential journeys by car
- If you can, take time out and enjoy the Air Show

The Great Yarmouth Air Show is being underwritten by the Greater Yarmouth Tourism & Business Improvement Area which has worked with a range of agencies including Great Yarmouth Borough Council, Norfolk Constabulary, Norfolk Fire & Rescue, East of England Ambulance Service and the Coastguard to help stage a safe, exciting event.

We would also like to thank the local residents for their support and patience during the event period.

Local residents will have the 'best seats in the house' but may need to make some changes to your routine over the Air Show weekend.



For safety and welfare reasons Marine Parade between the Britannia Pier and Wellington Pier will be **closed to vehicular movements from 18.00 on Friday 15th June until 08.00 on Monday 18th June**, which will also mean the closure of side roads adjoining Marine Parade. Pedestrian access will remain open at all times. The side roads affected include:-

Cars parked illegally in the road closure areas may be towed away.
